- Special Defence Event Permits are issued for the length of the event.
- A Special Defence Event Permit cannot be renewed.
- A Special Defence Event Permit is valid for possession of specified firearms, ammunition and firearm technology only.
- All persons wishing to be classified as Authorised Persons (inclusive of the Authorised Representative) must complete Part B of the application in full.
- All applicants must include a copy of their current Firearms Licence (with photo ID), current Drivers Licence (with photo ID) or current Passport to accompany this application.
- Special Defence Event Permits involving a B709 Importation Permit must include the pre-arranged pickup date given to them by Australian Border Force, and include full details of how the firearms, ammunition and firearm technology will be delivered, and where the firearms, ammunition and firearm technology will be stored for the duration of the event and full details of how the firearms, ammunition and firearm technology will leave Western Australia.
