## **Addendum advice**

Clarification of Project Eligibility Criteria (Section 3.3.2 of the applicant guidelines) Some of the criteria described as eligibility criteria in the applicant guidelines are to be assessed as part of the merit assessment and will not result in a project being considered ineligible. Clarification of each criterion is provided below.
