WA Signs of Safety Disciplines

Clear rigorous distinction between past harm, future danger and complicating factors

2

Clear rigorous distinction between strengths and protection

3

Plain language that is understood by the family and carries meaning

Statements with specific, observable behaviours that avoid meaning-laden labels

Culture guides practice at every step

Skilful use of authority

Assessment is always a work in progress
